



What is a Disability Friendly Champion?

Each Disability Friendly (DF) organisation will be required to nominate a DF Champion. The DF Champion will be the main point of contact with I Am Me Scotland and will provide updates on training and resources required, as well as complete a short annual survey.

What training is provided?

The DF Champion will complete the Disability friendly training package and will have access to the online portal, where they can access the training link, posters, contact cards, communication prompts etc. They can also contact the I Am Me team with any queries and can submit stories for inclusion in the bi-monthly newsletter.

What will the DF Champion have to do?

The DF Champion will be the main point of contact for the organisation. They will ensure that staff/volunteers are trained and that the organisation has the DF information available and window sticker in display. Each year, the I Am Me team will send a short survey asking how many people have been trained and if the organisation needs any more free resources.

Each year, the DF champions will be invited to submit any good news stories or examples of how their organisation has gone above and beyond. A Disability Friendly Organisation will be awarded each year!
