Disability Friendly is a national initiative developed by I Am Me Scotland to create a network of disability trained premises across Scotland.

The aim of the initiative is to provide free training to community organisations, helping disabled and vulnerable people to feel valued and supported within their communities.

The Contact Card can be used by anyone who needs it. The card holds information about an individual, their health and communication requirements as well as emergency contact details. Cards are available free from Disability Friendly places and can also be requested from iammescotland@outlook.com
